We are currently in the process of accepting applications to become this year's Miss St. Patrick. The chosen recipient will be crowned by this year's Parade Grand Marshal, at the Grand Marshal Dinner in February 2024. On Saturday, March 2, 2024, she will ride at the front of the Burlington Co St. Patrick's Day Parade in Mt Holly, New Jersey. Additionally, the winner will receive a scholarship award in the amount of \$1,000.

Interested applicants should be between the ages of 15 & 23 and meet one of the following requirements:

- ♣ Be a resident of Burlington County, New Jersey *and, or*
- ♣ Attend school in Burlington County *and, or*
- ♣ Have relatives or a sponsor who belongs to an local Irish organization or belong to one themselves in South Jersey or the Philadelphia area (AOH, parade committee, Irish Dance Group, Emerald Society, South Jersey Celtic Society etc)

To enter the competition, applicant must:

- ♣ Submit a completed application (enclosed and also available online at www.mounthollyparade.com)
- ♣ Submit a 1-2 page essay explaining what being Irish means to them. (Please stay on topic!!!)
- ♣ The Applicant may submit a short bio outlining their school accomplishments, activities & scholarship achievement along with their application.
- ♣ The applicant also may submit a letter of recommendation along with the application from a sponsor, member of a local Irish organization, teacher, guidance counselor, etc.
- ♣ Submit entries by February 1, 2024

Judges will review the entries and announce the next Miss St. Patrick in February. The winner will be required to attend the Grand Marshal and the Parade.
